DUES DEDUCTIBILITY

For federal income tax purposes, payments made to the AIA and its state components are not deductible as charitable deductions but are generally deductible as trade or business expenses, except for the percentage expended on lobbying state or federal governments. Accordingly, in 2007, **92.8%** of your national individual and supplemental dues, **68%** of state dues and **100%** of local dues are deductible expenses on federal tax forms.
